Stop by the gym foyer to check out our new **QUICK ... CLEAN ... GREEN ...** EZH2O Water Bottle Filling Station. Yes Crossley, the fountain in the gym foyer has undergone a transformation and is now equipped with a water bottle filling station. Simply place your water bottle on the bottle pad and without pushing a button your water bottle will be filled with filtered water before your very eyes. But wait ... Don't have time to run down to the gym foyer before class? A new fountain, equipped with a chiller and water bottle filling station, will soon be installed in the cafeteria **AND** on the third floor. But that's not all Crossley ... each bottle filling station is equipped with a **green ticker** that will help track the number of 500 mL plastic water bottles we save from landfills by using our EZH2O Water Bottle Filling Station to refill our reusable water bottle. Since Friday afternoon, 1,318 plastic bottles have already been saved.
