



STARTING November 30th all DSBN secondary schools will be changing their school course schedule from the two-week mini-blocks to a model of alternating one-week blocks. Study hall will continue as usual. There will not be a change to the students' cohorts, in person days or bell times. Niagara Region Public Health has reviewed the new schedule and has no concerns about the change.
