Dear Parent/Guardian:

One of the OSSD graduation requirements is the successful completion of the Ontario Secondary School Literacy Test (OSSLT). This year the test will be held on **Wednesday, March 27**th. It is administered to first time eligible Grade 10 students and previously eligible grade 11 & 12 students every year in schools across the province and subsequently marked centrally by provincial markers.

The District School Board of Niagara (DSBN) offers a number of programs to prepare students for this Literacy test. Our students are provided with the opportunity to write in smaller groupings and have as much time as required to complete the OSSLT, which is an optimal test-taking environment. Those students requiring accommodations will have them.

Our grade 9 students will be writing the DSBN Literacy Snapshot on this morning as well. This diagnostic assessment allows our teachers to provide optimal support in grade 10 classes and in preparation for the OSSLT next year.

For those students not writing the OSSLT or the Literacy Snapshot this is a regular school day. Grade 11 & 12 students will attend their regular classes and follow the schedule below.
