## **Self Screening**

• Students must complete the daily self-screening tool which has been updated to reflect the new protocols.

## Option to Learn from Home from January 17 to January 25

- Parents should continue reporting absences using <u>Safe Arrival</u>.
- From the 17th to the 25th, please use "Excused Learning Online" for students who choose to work from home but can engage with learning.
- Learning online from home is **only** available until the end of semester one and is asynchronous. Teachers will post work online for students learning from home to complete.
- For semester 2 which begins February 3, we are planning for a return to regular attendance protocols for all in person learners.

## **Culminating Activity Days from January 26 to January 31**

- To limit the congregation of students, ONLY students requiring completion of their culminating activity should attend school during these days.
- If students complete their culminating activity before this deadline, they are not required to attend school.
- Teachers will communicate with students who are required to participate.
- Cafeteria will not provide food services during this time.
- Our SSTC classes will continue to have instruction from January 26-28th, with a regular day schedule.

## It's everyone's responsibility to keep our schools safe. Please remind your student of the following:

- Schools will be enforcing our enhanced health & safety protocols especially those regarding limited seating in the cafeteria, appropriate mask use, and not congregating in the halls and washrooms.
- Progressive discipline measures may be used for those students who repeatedly disregard these protocols.
